The service operates between Preston City Centre and Longsands via Deepdale Road and Watling Street Road looping Longsands anti-clockwise. The service operates generally every hour during Monday to Saturday daytime. Rotala Preston Bus operate this service on behalf of Lancashire County Council.

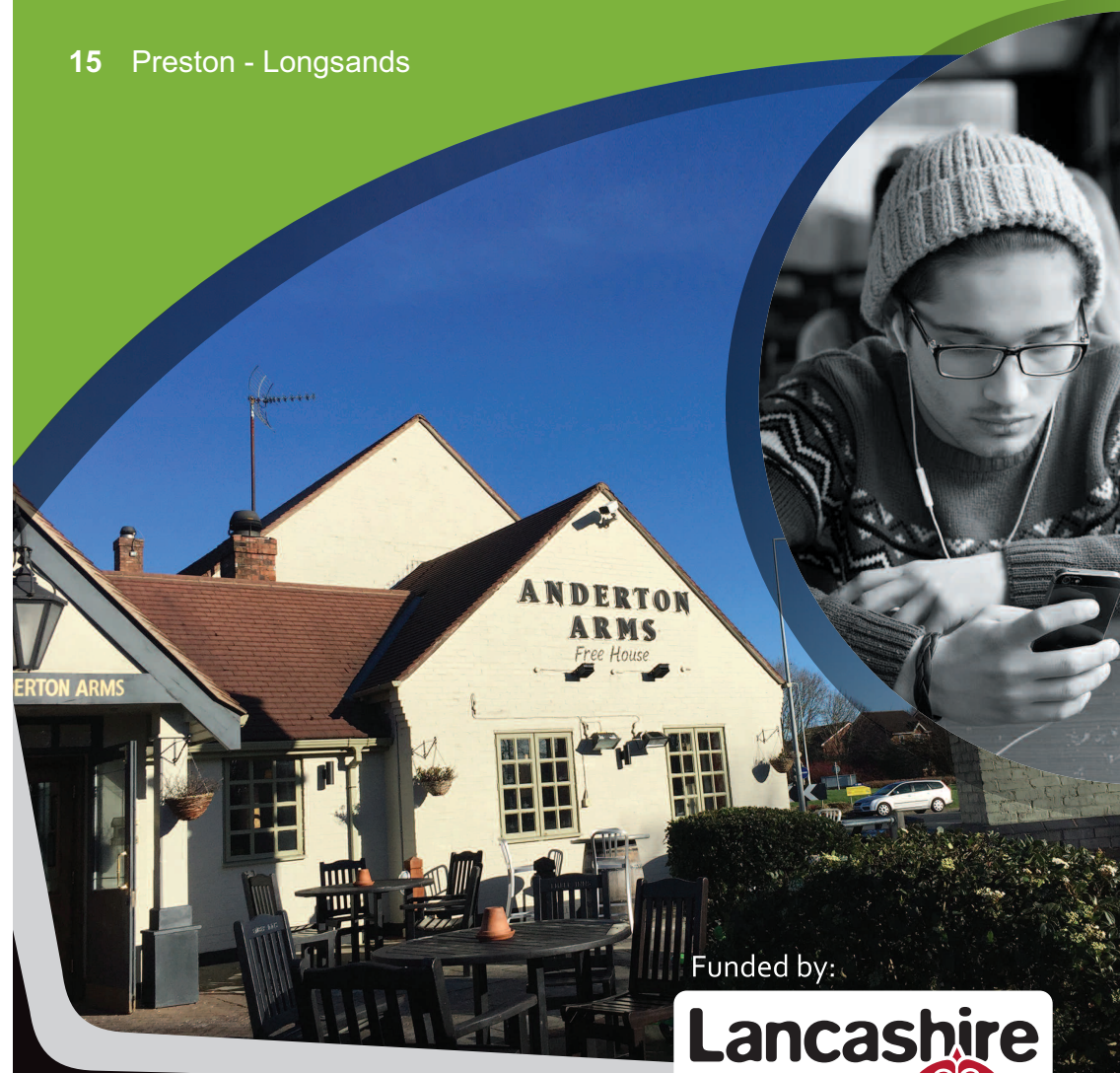
